


Time Signatures - $\frac{2}{2}$, C

 In $\frac{2}{2}$ time there are two beats in each measure.
 The half note gets one beat.


$\frac{2}{2}$ is often referred to as "cut" time.

$\frac{2}{2}$ may also be displayed as C .

Rhythmic values


A quarter note (♩) = 1/2 beat
A half note (♪) = 1 beat
A whole note (♩) = 2 beats

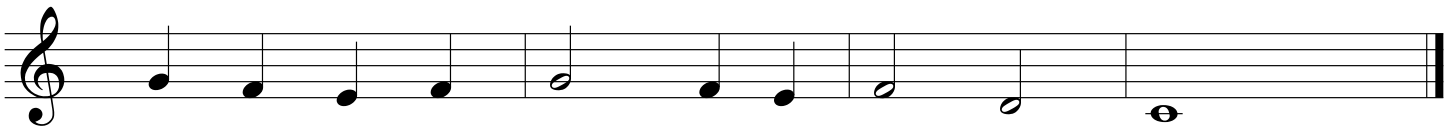

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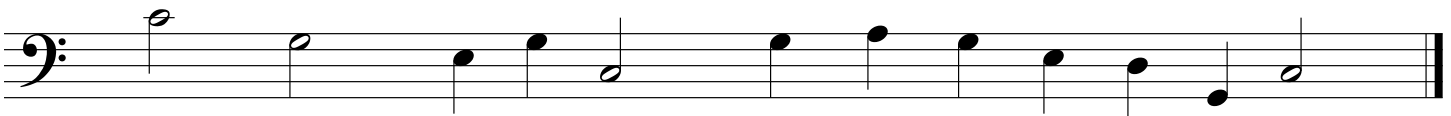

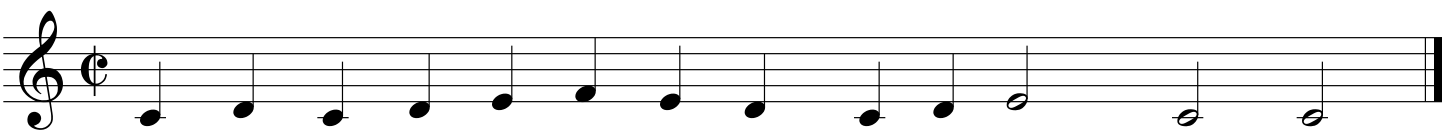
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4. Write a $\frac{2}{2}$ time signature after the clef sign. Write in the count below the notes. Draw the missing bar lines.
